"On Your Potty" and "Hello / Goodbye"

At pre-school we will be ...

Using books, props and talk about using a potty or the toilet story. Lots of positive praise. Encourage the children to greet each other in a friendly way	Using the stepping stones (indoors) to promote physical, imaginary and role play. Put numbers on them to encourage recognition / counting	Using writing areas for mark making and then take ownership of own work by finding name card and putting them in the rack to take home.
Using the Duplo to build and construct – using imagination to create small world play. Working individually and together	Sitting together at snack time – talk about hygiene, hand washing, tasting new food, sitting together, being safe in the sun, etc	Talk about transition and encouraging them to think about next settings – having visits from and to other settings.
Using key person support to ensure children are making progress and checking that we have recorded where they are at and what next steps need to be. Co-ordinate with other settings and writing leavers reports.	Using the tuff tray with bark chippings, insects and other natural resources for imaginary play – staff will be encouraging sharing / turn taking and promoting descriptive language	Pouring/ measuring in the small water play tray. This is good activity for promoting mathematical thinking and language – e.g. up/down, big/small and promotes physical and social play
Using chalks / paint brushes and water to make marks on the patio and outside walls. Using paint dabbers to make individual pictures	Using imagination when playing in the nature garden / mud kitchen – looking for insects, digging, watering garden	Using bikes, scooters, balls, etc (garden) – promoting physical, communication and social skills. Include literacy / numeracy outside.
